Nina Patrikidou, *Violin*

Mrs Nina Patrikidou was born in Russia where she studied violin. She obtained her violin diploma from the David Oistrakh's Violin Department of the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory under B. Belenky. She has performed in Russia, Italy, France, Germany, England, Belgium, Cyprus, Hungary, Bulgaria and in most cities of Greece. She has founded the Violin Days Festival of Skiathos as well as many chamber music groups and the Children and Youth Symphony Orchestra under the auspices of the Greek National Radio Television Corporation. As an orchestra conductor she has toured Greece with the opera Matrimonio Secreto and has directed the Children and Youth Symphony Orchestra in the Concert Hall of Athens, the Concert Hall of Thessaloniki and many other Greek cities.



Evgenia Votanopoulou, *Piano*

Mars Evgenia Votanopoulou was born and educated in Athens, Greece. At the age of five she started playing the piano. She studied with L. Boyadjieva, A. Papastefanou and L. Stoyanova and in 1992 she graduated with distinction from the National Conservatory of Athens, Greece having obtained the Diploma of Piano but also Degrees in Harmony, Counterpoint and Fugue. In 1998 Evgenia represented Greece at the Second International Women's Musical Meeting. She has given numerous performances as a solist, a chamber musician and a piano accompanist in Greece, Serbia and Germany. She is currently a Professor of Piano at the Conservatory of Aghios Stefanos and Professor of Music at the Arsakeio School of Athens.
